Meeting was called to order at 6:00 P.M.

Approve Minutes: Motion by Zuelsdorf, 2ed by Marschke, to approve April minutes, all voting aye, motion passed.

Public Appearances: Lahnne Neu thanked the Park Board on behalf of the Living History Days, asked if there was any feedback or concerns from this year's event. Would like to present next year's event and the possible move to River Bend Park at our next meeting.
