

## Park Board Minutes for June 8th, 2016

Meeting was called to order at 6:00 P.M.

Approve Minutes: Motion by Marschke, 2ed by Zuelsdorf, to approve May's minutes, all voting aye, motion passed.

Public Appearances: None.

Parks Report: A John Deere group will help install Horse Shoe pits at Discher Park. There will be a Legion and Jr. Legion baseball team this year, all fees have been paid. John Deere has not been able to keep up with mowing commitments, city crew will try to catch up. There may be a deer issue in the parks, numbers of 35 were counted by Utility crew while flushing hydrants. Pool slides have been inspected and passed we should get 10 more years of use from them. Installed new rock in slide area, replaced rule sign, planted new tree by guard station near diving boards.

Aquatic Center Report: Riley Krueel gave report on pool, first four days saw 192 total swimmers with one day closed due to weather. 69 passes sold at pool so far this does not reflect sales at city hall.

Rec Report: Baseball games started May 16. Softball games started on May 23. T-ball started on June 6. The soccer program ended on May 26<sup>th</sup>. A thank you to parks department for rolling the outfields and mowing of the fields they are looking real nice.

There was a motion by Zuelsdorf, second by Frami to not allow Hot Dog stand use of Discher Park food stand full time. All voting aye motion passed.

Motion by Zuelsdorf, Second by Miller to allow the High school use of River Bend for cross country meets on Sept 1<sup>st</sup>, 22ed. Oct 13<sup>th</sup> .All voting aye motion passed.

Motion by Marschke, Second by Frami to purchase a freezer for pool not to exceed \$400 plus tax. A vote of 4 to one motion passed. (Zuelsdorf lone no vote).

Non-Action: there has been a report of a Great Dane drinking from the water bubbler in River Bend. Still having issues with pet clean up in the park.

Any Board member wishing to tour the pool after the meeting adjourns may do so.
