

The Public Works & Development Committee met in session with Chairperson Fausett presiding. The meeting was called to order at 6:01 p.m.

Members present: Forrest Frami and Carl Fausett

Members absent: Don Miller

Others in attendance: Mayor Steve Neitzel and Dave Magnussen, DPW/Utilities Supervisor

Public Appearances: None.

Motion by Frami, second by Fausett, to approve the minutes of the previous meeting as printed. All voting AYE. Motion carried.

The Committee reviewed the ATV policy for the City of Horicon and thought it best to review as two separate issues: the Raasch Hill Road to Discher parking lot trail for the Town of Williamstown ATV Trail; and the driving of off-road vehicles on other City Streets.

The Committee defined the connector route to the Discher lot as from the corporate City limits on Raasch Hill Road to the junction with Clason Street (Hwy 28), north on Clason to the junction with Ellsworth Street and then Ellsworth to the intersection at N. Palmatory Street. The parking area for the ATV's and their support vehicles shall be the parking lot at the corner of N. Palmatory and Joanna Streets. It was further agreed that the Horicon DPW shall be responsible for the appropriate signage for this trail.

The Committee then reviewed the permissions and permitting for the use of off-road vehicles on City streets. Much discussion was held and a preliminary consensus was arrived at with Forrest Frami agreeing to type out the first outline and presenting it at the February Public Works and Development meeting for further discussion and development.

Leslie Covell Hirschberger, from the Blue Zone Group, joined the meeting at 6:44 p.m.

The Committee reviewed the previous drafts of the Complete Streets Policy and made final revisions.

Motion by Fausett, second by Frami, to recommend the approval of the Complete Streets Policy and Implementation Plan and to place it on the Council agenda for the January 23, 2018 meeting. All voting AYE. Motion carried.

Non-Action Discussion:

The proposed extension of the Bowling Green River Walk behind the Rock River Place was discussed. The Committee agreed that it should be included in the Developer's Agreement for Rock River Place.

The next meeting was scheduled for Thursday, February 1, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. at the DPW meeting room.

Motion by Frami, second by Fausett, to adjourn.

All voting AYE. The meeting adjourned at 8:12 p.m.
