

The Committee of Whole of the City of Horicon met in regular session on January 24, 2017. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Neitzel at 6:01 p.m.

Mayor Neitzel led the Pledge of Allegiance.


Don Neitzel of Kunkel Engineering provided an overview of the Washington Street Reconstruction Project. Neitzel stated the Project would extend from Main Street east to Valley Street. The Project would include replacement of water main, storm sewer, installation of sidewalk on both sides, installation of curb and gutter, and installation of asphalt. Neitzel added it was also necessary for Washington Street to have a new road base as sufficient base was never installed. Neitzel stated Washington Street would be a 41 foot back to back street.

An opportunity was provided for Washington Street property owners to ask questions. Items discussed during this time included constant access to property for Leroy Meats, payment options for the assessments, driveway openings, public hearing for the assessments, and credits for existing curb and gutter.

Don Neitzel distributed a Final Assessment for the Pheasant Lane/Robin Road/Green Tree Road Project for the Committee to review. Neitzel advised the Washington Street Project is similar to the Pheasant Lane/Robin Road/Green Tree Road Project as none of the streets were fully improved prior to the projects. Neitzel announced he would require Council action stipulating what items would be assessable to the property owner prior to preparing the preliminary assessments.

Motion by Fausett, second by Marschke, to adjourn.
