

The Public Works & Development Committee met with Chairperson Carl Fausett presiding. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.

The Sidewalk Snow Removal Ordinance revision from Attorney Plier was reviewed paragraph by paragraph. Fausett recommended that one more subsection regarding Notices be added. Fausett and Magnussen drafted the new subsection to be given to Attorney Plier with all members in agreement.

Motion by Frami, second by Fausett, to advance the draft of the Snow Removal Ordinance revision to Council for approval.

Non-Action Discussion:

The proposal from Strand for the Urban Non-Point Source Grant application was discussed.


Also discussed was the Wastewater roof and HVAC project with Magnussen pointing out that the HVAC is fairly new so he thought it could be removed from the bid and the money used elsewhere. The bid opening for this project is April 28 at 2:00 p.m.

Discussion was held in regard to the roof condition at the old canning factory on S. Hubbard Street. It was felt that the building needs a current inspection and perhaps a flyover by the DPW drone to take a look at the roof.

Discussion was held regarding grass clippings blown into the street by residents and the DNR's increased attention to our phosphorus output. Fines and penalties were reviewed and the committee agreed to place this as an action item on the next agenda.

Motion by Miller, second by Frami, to adjourn.
