Mayor Grigg announced there was no quorum but as this was an informational meeting only the meeting will proceed.


Aldersperson Anfinson arrived at 5:04 p.m.

Don Neitzel of Kunkel Engineering provided an overview of the West Lake Street Reconstruction Project. The Project will include replacement of the road with concrete, curb and gutter, and potentially some driveways. The scope of the Project is Industrial Drive east to the Lake Street Bridge. The Project will be divided into 2 phases with the 1st phase being Industrial Drive to the railroad tracks, scheduled to begin July 9th and completed by Labor Day. Phase 2 extends from the railroad tracks to the Lake Street Bridge and will begin after Labor Day. There will be no assessments to the property owners.

An opportunity was provided for property owners to ask questions. Items discussed during this time included: speed limit on West Lake Street, widening of the street, bike trail, and pavement marking.
