

City of Horicon, Department of Public Works Meeting Minutes for July 12, 2018.

Call to order at 6:08PM

Members present: Magnussen, Miller, and Vanderhei.

Members absent: Anfinson.

Public Appearances: Glenn Daily, Mary Doughty, from Friends of Dodge County Parks. Leslie Covellhershberger from Blue Zone.

The Friends of Dodge County gave a recommendation of the bike path for the Gold Star Memorial Trail through Horicon. It would be N. Palmantory, to Walnut, to Vine, to W Lake Street.

Worked on city bike routes around the city, reviewed the 2009 bike plan approved by Council. This will be used in the master bike plan for the Blue Zone.

Will continue to work on the bike routes in order to have them firmed up for council's approval next month.

Worked on the ATV/UTV trail policy received from the City of Fonda, Iowa. Will have a firm plan for next month's meeting.

The WPDES permit is into the DNR for them to review. May be several months before we hear back from them.

There was a motion by Vanderhei, second by Miller to use the \$19,240 left over from the mill & overlay to redo the DPW parking lot. All voting aye motion passed.

Motion by Vanderhei, second by Miller to approve the contract with Utility Services Co. for the Clinton Street water tower. All voting aye motion passed.

In non-action Vanderhei informed the committee there is a Bee problem at Discher Park. He also gave Dave information on spray application. Public Safety recommends painting the curb yellow in front of Kwik Trip at Barstow Street.

Question was asked about the junk cars at the DWP, as they have been there five month's now. An idea was to let the Fire Department use them for training.
