






Operations & Training: Calls w/o reports included 124 business / residential security checks, 25 ambulance assists, 21 paper/process services, 17 suspicious activity calls, 17 ordinance violation calls, 19 animal complaints, and 13 follow-up investigative actions. Adopt-A-Ward saw 16 contacts during the month (all were at the Awareness level). There were 8 for Improper Storage, 4 for Junk Accumulation, 3 for 48-hour Parking, 2 for Grass/Weeds, and 2 for storing a broken-down trailer and a boat on City Streets. The 3rd Quarter Adopt-A-Ward report is attached. The School Partnership Program saw 8 events where officers participated in daily activities, handed out Packer Football card packs (co-sponsored by Horicon Police, Krizan Insurance, and American Family Insurance), and engaged with students during lunch and recess.

Staffing & Overtime: There were 289 hours paid-not-worked in September (210 sick, 54 vacation, 16 floating holiday, and 9 comp time). The 93.5 hours of OT were 49.25 hours of Operational OT (35.25 training, 9 late calls/reports, and 5 drug enforcement). The 44 hours of Administrative OT was filled by part time officers (35.5 hours) and full time officers (8.5 hours). There were 86 patrol hours unfilled by supervisory coverage, flex schedule coverage, or went unstaffed.
