


Chief Adamson's Comments:

Operations & Training: It's clear that Mother Nature has had a chilling effect on calls for service this spring unlike last spring. Our drug offenses spiked this month with 12 arrests or referrals; one of which included 7.9 grams of cocaine and 4 doses (hits) of suspected LSD. The Heroin Summit was well attended and provided a great opportunity to discuss a difficult topic. The youth Heroin Summit is scheduled for May 13th at Horicon Jr/Sr High during the day. Calls w/o reports saw 178 security checks, 34 paper/process services, 29 miscellaneous complaints, 23 ambulance assists, and 18 follow-up investigative services..

Staffing & Overtime: Operational OT included 58 hours finishing state-mandated training, 20 hours supporting the Heroin Summit, and 13 hours of court. Administrative OT was 71.25 hours. The difference between Paid-not-Worked (123.5 hrs) and Administrative OT (71.25 hrs) is 52.25 hrs. In short we were able to cover more than 50 hours of Administrative OT (earned benefit time) through schedule design or supervisors covering.
