


Operations & Training: Calls w/o reports included 202 business or home security checks, 39 follow-up investigative actions, 15 ambulance assists, and 10 animal complaints along with a wide variety of incidents with single digit frequencies. We continue to work with all 3 schools to implement our age-appropriate workbook series from LAW Publications. We also continue to work with the 3 schools on implementing a viable portable radio communication capacity in concert with our Unified Crisis Response Plan. The Wisconsin State Patrol has gifted 20 radios for this function which should be fielded in the near future. One officer attended training in December and completed his certification as a Glock Armorer so he can perform technical inspections and maintain our handguns. Adopt-A-Ward saw 17 contacts for Junk Vehicles (2), Grass/Weeds (2), Junk Accumulation (5), Brush Piles (1), 48-hour Parking (4), and Animals at Large (3).

Staffing & Overtime: The lieutenant will be onboard January 11th and will be at the Council Meeting on January 13th at 6PM. This will bring our full-time staff to it's current authorized level. Operational overtime was 56.75 hours and consisted mostly of drug enforcement and annual evidence inventory. Administrative overtime was 105 hours of filling mandatory minimum patrol staffing as full-time officers took vacation, holiday, and floating holiday time in December.
