





### Chief Adamson's Comments:

**Operations & Training:** Services w/o reports included 168 security checks, 39 miscellaneous complaints, 34 paper / process services, 26 follow-up contacts, and 12 ambulance assists. Part-time Officer Derek Harmsen completed training and is available to fill open / vacant shifts. Starting in April we will be promoting bicycle registration throughout the City to include the schools, parks, and the Aquatic Center. Rx Drug Drop is scheduled for April 26 from 10AM-2PM. We are also co-sponsoring a Heroin Summit with the Horicon Area School District on April 10<sup>th</sup>. Horicon received 36 services from outside agencies including Mayville, Dodge County, and State Patrol. Adopt-A-Ward saw 29 contacts w/ the most for sidewalk snow removal, junk cars, and furniture at the curb.

**Staffing & Overtime:** All overtime was Operational OT with 16 hours of training, 7 hours of firearms/range operations, 6 hours of court, 6 hours of late calls, and 4 hours of drug enforcement. There were 37.5 hours of paid-not-worked in February that was covered w/o paying overtime.
