






Operations & Training: Calls w/o reports were comprised of 134 residential/business security checks, 48 miscellaneous complaints, 26 paper/process services, 25 follow-up investigative actions, 18 EMS calls, and 14 animal complaints. No officers attended training this month. Adopt-A-Ward activity this month saw seven Awareness issues resolved and three Warnings issued. There will be a 6-month roll-up sent out before the July 22nd Council meeting.

Staffing & Overtime: There were 194 hours of paid-not-worked. Of those hours we were able to fill all but 88 hours by the Chief or Lieutenant working, flexing a scheduled officer, or by not filling it. The remaining 88 hours were covered by part-time officers. Moving everything for carpeting installation within the PD, Court Clerk's Office, Fire Chief's Office, EMS Coordinator's Office, EMS report writing room, and the Fire Department Radio Room was a herculean task that was only made possible by the hard work, coordination, and understanding of every department involved. The effort was spearheaded by Lieutenant Roy. Operational OT was minimal at 24.5 hours with 14 of them being dedicated to moving stuff for carpet installation at the PSB.
