The City of Horicon has initiated a Public /Private Tree Planting program.

This program reimburses property owners in the City of Horicon for planting trees on private property along with providing information and guidance on planting of your beautiful new trees.

Trees are recognized in Horicon for their economic, environmental and health benefits. Having a sufficient tree canopy in the City is one step of many, in providing a vibrant and healthy community.

- * Receive a 50% reimbursement, up to \$50.00 for each tree planted.
- * Two trees allowed per application.
- * Two applications per year.
- * Priority will be given to new applicants, applicants that have lost trees to Emerald Ash Borer and private residential property.
- * This programs length of operation is determined by funding availability.

Submit the receipt(s) for tree purchase and completed application to the Horicon Tree Board at Horicon City Hall, 404 E Lake Street.

Reimbursement will be after trees are planted.

Please allow 6-8 weeks for processing.

Common hackberry, Kentucky Coffeetree, Corktree, London Planetree Baldcypress, Oak, Linden, American Elm, Maple, Turkish filbert Ginkgo, Thornless Honeylocust, Ironwood, Catalpa

Small Trees

Shantung Maple, Thornless Cockspur Hawthorn, Flowering Crabapple, Cherry, Japanese Tree Lilac, Service Berry


