

The Common Council of the City of Horicon met in special session via video conference with Mayor Grigg presiding. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.

Alders Present: Hady, Marschke, Bandsma, and Miller.

Alders Absent: Frami and Vanderhei.

Motion by Bandsma, second by Hady, to authorize purchase of a 2021 Ford Police Interceptor Utility AWD from Ewald Automotive Group in the amount of \$33,002 per the 2021 Budget.

Vanderhei arrived at 6:04 p.m.

Discussion was held on whether this item was covered during the discussion on the 2021 Budget.

Vote on above motion.

Voting AYE: Bandsma, Vanderhei, Hady, and Marschke.

Voting NAY: Miller.

Motion carried.

Motion by Hady, second by Vanderhei, to authorize purchase of a 2021 Ford F550 4x4 on a Custom Horton Conversion Model 623 (ambulance) from Foster Coach Sales Inc. in the amount of \$265,363 per the 2021 Budget.

All voting AYE. Motion carried.

Mayor Grigg acknowledged non-action discussion was not included on the agenda but asked if anyone had anything they wished to say.


Mayor Grigg stated he believed the purchase of a squad car was covered at the 2021 Budget meeting.
