**DPW Updates:**

- New truck is here and in service.
- Bids for the Lake Street project were opened with Ptaschinski Contraction Inc, having the low bid in the amount of \$541,022.80.
- Crosswalk signage equipment for Lake Street is finished and working.

**Water/Wastewater Updates:**

- Will continue to do limited meter change outs in residents due to Covid.
- Water break on Valley Street on 12/16/2020.
- Survey's on S. Finch, S. Cedar, and Minerva Street were completed the end of December.
- Rare Earth chemical is being applied and we are below 0.3mg/L Phosphorus.
- Work on Pool slides as well as other projects at the pool is ongoing.
- Looking into replacing the Grit handling screens in the amount of \$4,251.00.

Looking at setting assessment standards for all future street projects. More information to come next month.

Looking into a 3% Water rate increase.
