

**City of Horicon      Public Works & Development Minutes      February 11, 2021**

The Public Works and Development Committee meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by Chairman Don Miller.

Members Present: Miller and Bandsma.

Members Absent: Vanderhei.

Motion by Bandsma, second by Miller, to approve the minutes for January 14, 2020. All voting Aye. Motion carried.

Blue Zones:

- County wide there was 1,060 boxes of food given out, 600 at the Dodge County Fairgrounds. The next giveaway will be February 26<sup>th</sup>.
- Will have the Safe Route to School Mapping presentation at the March meeting.

Don Neitzel, from Kunkel Engineering reviewed the Kansas Street project with the committee. Will move to Special Common Council Meeting on February 18<sup>th</sup>.

DPW Updates:

- Had 6 snow events in January.
- Tree City application for the 34<sup>th</sup> year is completed.
- Reordered salt supply for February.
- Interviews for the Heavy Equipment Operator will be on February 24<sup>th</sup>.

Water/Wastewater Updates:

- Service shutoff to resume in April as permitted by PSC.
- Annual PSC and audit is underway.
- Final MDV costs verified in the amount of \$14,838.00 with sub-payments due to Dodge, Fond du lac, Jefferson, and Washington Counties prior to 03/01/2021.
- Rare Earth chemical is being applied and we are below 0.4mg/L Phosphorus.
- Sewer backup on East Walnut due to the sewer main being plugged. Will move to Council for payment for the plumber's bill.
- 3% water rate increase in water rate. Will move to Council for approval.

Non-Action Discussion:

- East Lake Street preconstruction meeting will be on February 25<sup>th</sup>.
