



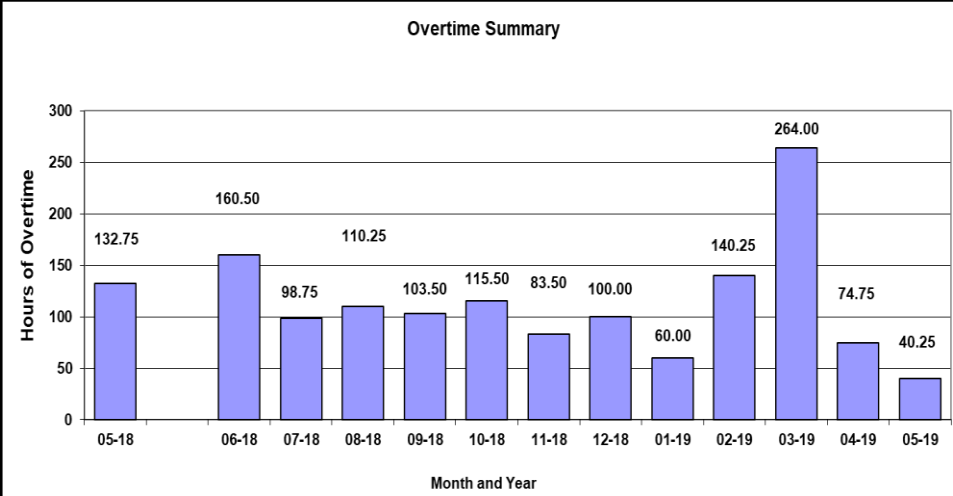
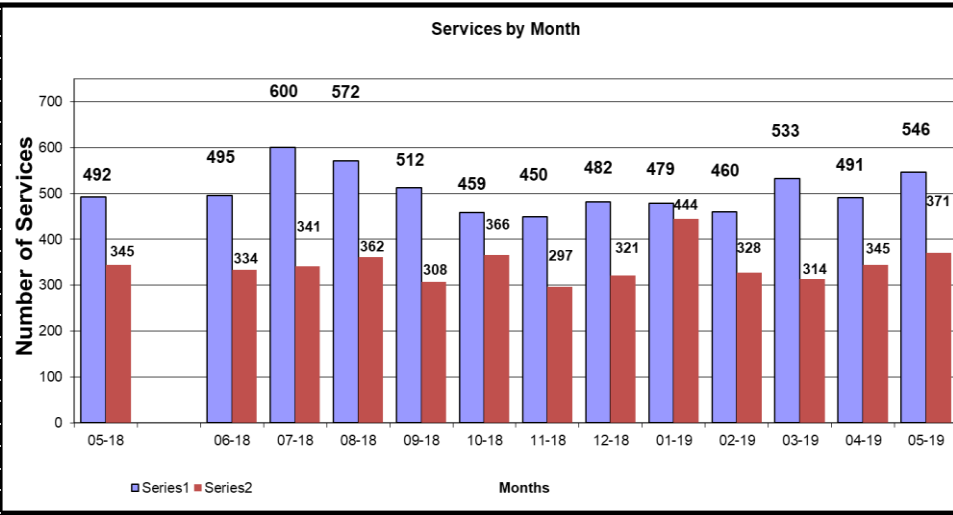

Operations & Training: Calls included 126 business/residential security checks, 94 traffic enforcement assignments (targeted enforcement areas), 31 paper / process services, 16 ordinance violations, 15 animal complaints, 14 residential welfare checks, 12 agency assists, and 8 vehicle lock-out assists. Assisted in the review of the County Hazard Mitigation Plan. Horicon PD became first municipality to “go live” with eReferrals to the DA’s Office. Conducted Crisis Action Plan exercise w/ Public Schools. Met w/ Bureau of Transportation Safety (BOTS) area coordinator to finalize 2019 BOTS Speed Enforcement Safety Grant. Conducted quarterly department meeting/training session focused on investigation tracking and closure, new roles and responsibilities, leveraging Spillman to build photo line-ups. All officers conducted semi-annual firearms qualification.

Staffing & Overtime: Hosted Lieutenant Saunders retirement send-off. There were 180 hrs of paid-ot-worked and 40.25 hrs of OT (28.25 Operational and 12 Administrative). 120 of the 180 hrs paid-not-worked was vacation w/ the rest balanced between sick, holiday, and comp time. There were 96 patrol hours that were covered by a supervisor or went unfilled.
