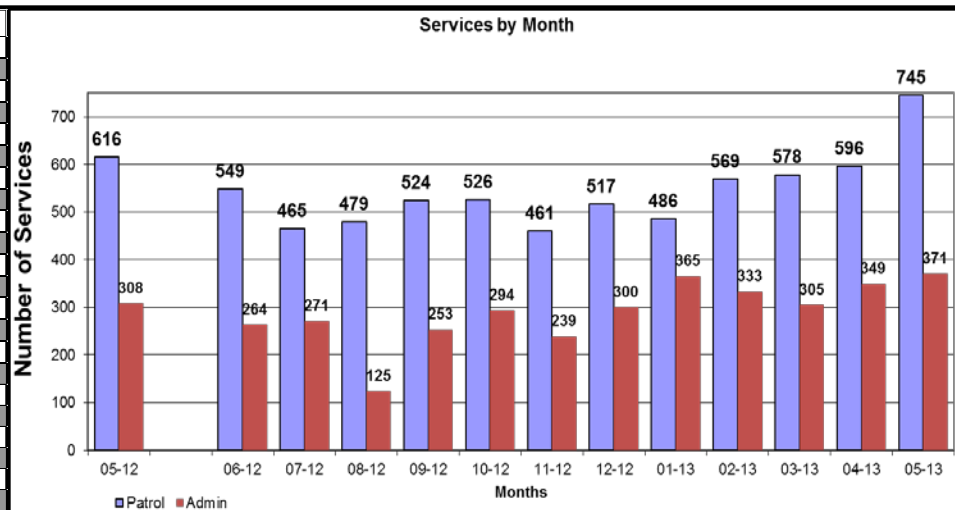




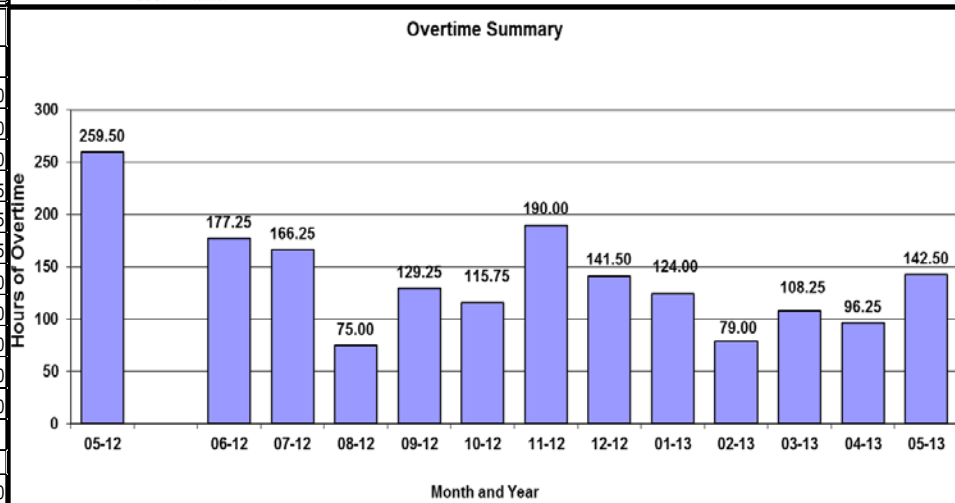

Chief Adamson's Comments:

➤ **Operations & Training:** As you can see from the above graph the demands for police services were up sharply from last month. The calls w/o reports category this month was again dominated by traffic stops (138), business security checks (122) follow-up investigative stops, paper service attempts (38), animal complaints (36) EMS calls (23), and suspicious vehicles/persons (22). Parking enforcement continues to be a challenge as officers try to balance calls-for-service with discretionary patrol time activities (like parking enforcement).

➤ **Staffing & Overtime:** Officer Jason Roy has been temporarily assigned as the Patrol Lieutenant pending resolution of residency requirements. Efforts are underway to posture the PD for smoothly backfilling the anticipated patrol officer vacancy with the Police & Fire Commission. We had 64.25 hours of operational overtime and 78.25 hours of administrative overtime. There were 56 hours of paid-not-worked time.
