Notice of Curbside Leaf Waste Pickup

City of Horicon curbside leaf pickup operations will begin the week of October 21, 2019 this year. Leaf wastes will be removed from behind the back of curb on all City streets thereafter by the City crews during the next few weeks. Residents may alternatively haul their leaf wastes to other City designated locations including: 1. DPW site on Valley Street; 2. Discher Park parking lot area on Jersey Street; or, 3. Legion Auxiliary Park locations. Residents are also reminded:

- NO BAGGED WASTE should be placed for removal, only loose leaf and grass clipping materials will be removed by City;
- It is unlawful to place leaves or grass clippings onto the pavement surface of public streets, ideally the waste is temporarily stored between the sidewalks and curb in the road terrace;
- Whenever possible, place leaves for removal in locations away from storm sewer (street) drains so not to promote clogged drainage of the street; and,
- Whenever possible, help the City crews by not parking in front of leaf piles, this improves access for removal and significantly speeds up the collection process for the City.

There will not be leaf pickup performed by the City after a November 22, 2019 program end date. Resident leaf wastes thereafter must be hauled to the DPW site by the Resident after the program end date. There is no spring leaf pickup service planned for this next year.
